4. eschatology	the doctrine of death, judgement, heaven and hell; to do with the end of times or last days
5. extermination	rooting out and destroying/killing
6. gentile	a person not of Jewish faith
7. holy spirit	part of the Trinity; the Spirit of God
8. idyll	is a perfect situation or world
9. inauguration	is the first public use of something; initiation ceremony
10. jinn	in the Islamic tradition, a spiritual, angelic-like being, sometimes evil
11. karma	the effect of a person's actions and conduct during their life; it is regard as determining the person's future destiny and experiences
12. koan	a riddle that has no solution which is used in Zen Buddhism to show the inadequacy of logical reasoning
13. mahabharata	referred to as the 'great story of India' and documents the war between rival dynasties in the first millennia BCE
14. messiah	a promised deliverer of oppressed people, especially the Jews
15. mettabhavana	a from of meditation which aims to cultivate loving kindness without attachment towards all living beings
16. moderate	in politics, a person or part taking the middle road; not extreme in views
17. nirvana	a place or state characterised by freedom from oblivion to pain, worry, and the external world
18. perpetual	means never ending, eternal
19. persecution	the act of pursuing someone in order to cause harm or injury
