1. **cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)** a life-sustaining procedure that uses rescue breathing and chest compressions to stimulate blood flow and oxygen delivery when a person has stopped breathing or their heart has stopped beating

 2. **chest compressions** downward thrusts on the centre of the chest that stimulate blood flow to vital organs in the body

 3. **defibrillator** a device that provides an electric shock to a patient whose heart has stopped beating

 4. **hepatitis** a disease that causes varying degrees of inflammation and subsequent damage to the liver

 5. **rescue breath** a breath given to a patient who is not breathing; the breath will take one second to deliver and will make the patient's chest rise
